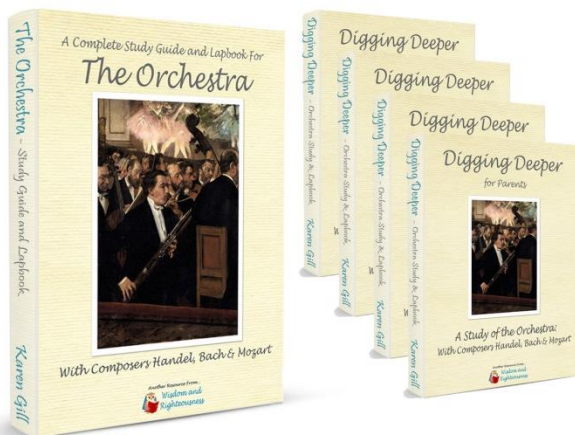
This resource has four different formats:

- **Section 4: Advanced Cursive – Freehand copy of cursive text onto single line**

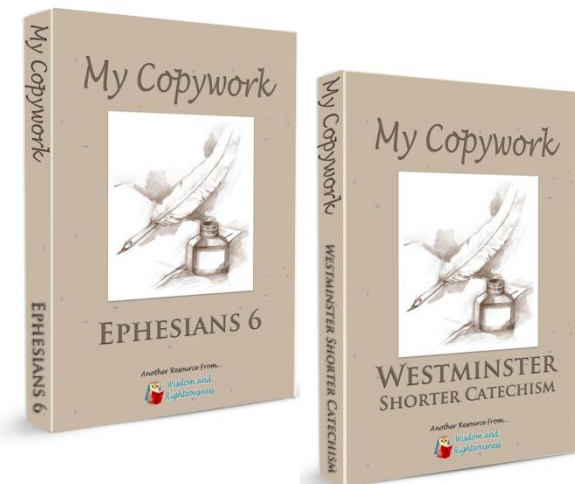

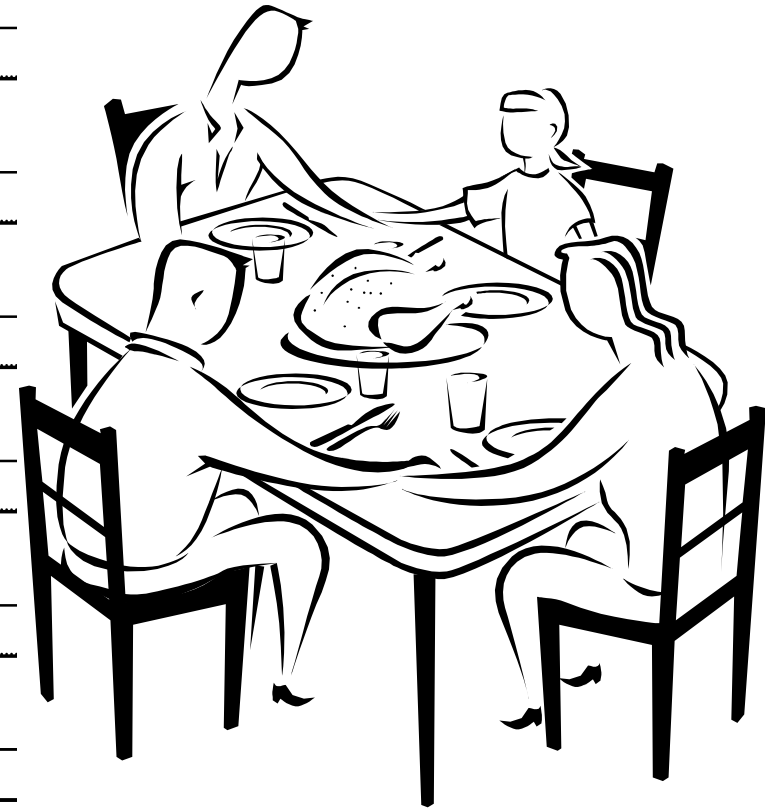

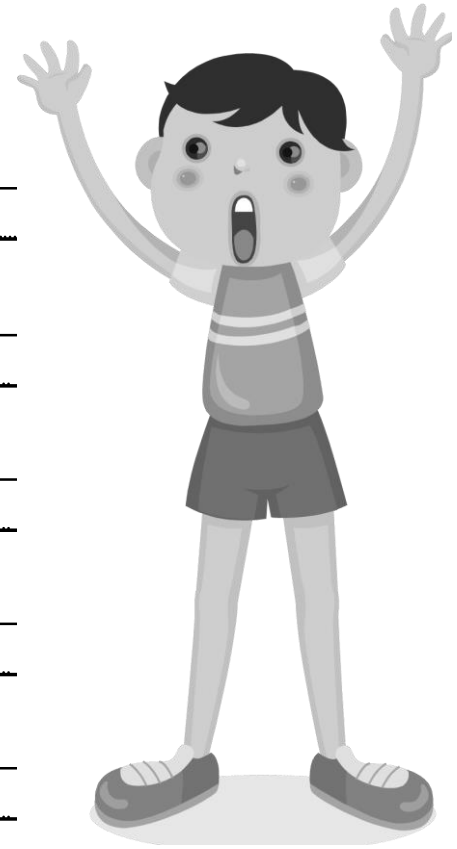
