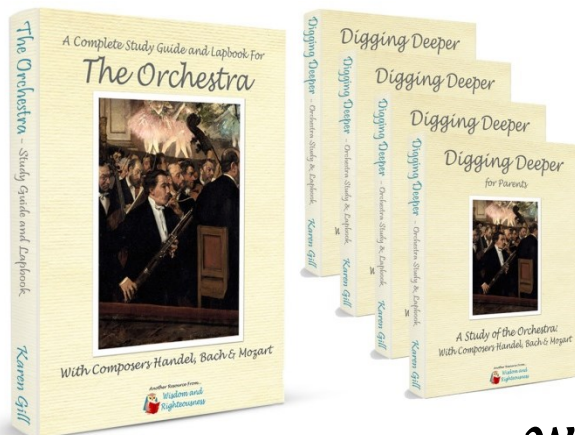
This resource has four different formats:

- **Section 4: Advanced Cursive – Freehand copy of cursive text onto double line**

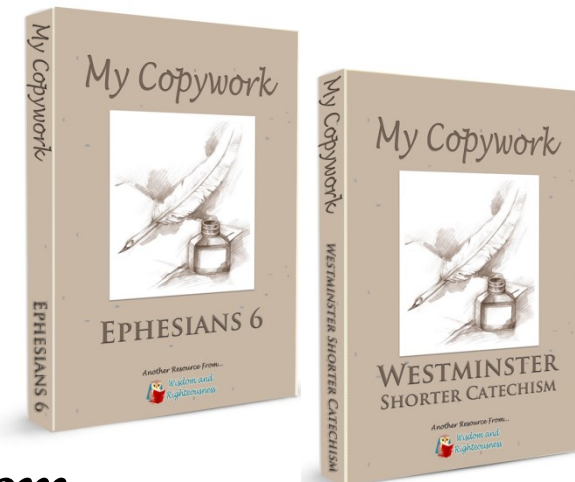
**It is my hope that this resource can be shared

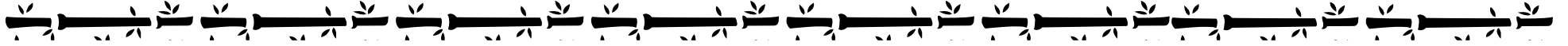
